Counselling Round - 2

Notification

Second round of counselling for 138 Seats of Engineering and 75 seats of General degree will be conducted on 13th August, 2016 from 9 am onwards at NITTTR, Chandigarh. These seats are available due to seats remaining vacant in the first round and conversion from unused quota.

Candidates with merit number given below are ONLY invited to attend Round-2 Counselling.

Engineering Stream	:	Merit No. 3704 to 4500
General Stream	:	Merit No. 6285 to Last Number

All the invited students coming for the counselling however may please note that, invitation to the counselling doesn't guarantee any seat. Seats will be allocated purely based on common merit and availability of seats at the time of your turn.

Candidates who are allotted seats in first round of counselling are NOT eligible to participate in the second round. However, those who were not able to attend the counselling Round-1 due to ill health may also be allowed. These students will be required to submit the proof of hospitalization on the day of Round-1.

List of AICTE approved Engineering Colleges with seats filled in is available on our website. All the students are advised to do some homework and come prepared with the list of 20 to 50 colleges of their choice where seats are available. It is useful to be ready with the name of the institute (and the institute code), and also course (and the course code) of your choice.
