Dear Sir/Madam,



The 7<sup>th</sup> National Education Day was celebrated on 11<sup>th</sup> November, 2014 at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi which was presided over by Hon'ble HRM, Smt. Smriti Zubin Irani and Hon'ble President of India, Shri Pranab Mukherjee was Chief Guest of the function.

This year, 8<sup>th</sup> National Education day on 11<sup>th</sup> November, 2015 is coinciding with Deepawali. It has, therefore, been decided that online essay competitions may be organized, for which the awards could be announced on 11<sup>th</sup> November 2015.

The Director, State Technical Education has been requested to organize and conduct the online essay competition. AICTE will award 3 cash prizes of Rs. 5000/- (1<sup>st</sup> Prize), Rs. 3000/- (2<sup>nd</sup> Prize) and Rs. 2000/- (3<sup>rd</sup> Prize) respectively for each State/UT. You are therefore, requested to liaise with Director, State Technical Education in this regard and give wide publicity in your institute to encourage maximum participation of students in this celebration of the 8<sup>th</sup> National Education Day.

## **GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR NATIONAL EDUCATION DAY ESSAY COMPETITION**

The Essay competition is open to all the students of Technical Institutes/AICTE Approved Institutes and topic for the essay is "**Importance of Education and Nation Commitment to Education at Large**" (or) as notified by the respective State Directorate of Technical Education (DTE). Students can submit their essays only through the e-mail address which is notified in the circular issued by the respective state Directorate of Technical Education (or) AICTE Regional Office e-mail address.

**Also, students are requested to strictly follow the guidelines issued by the respective State Directorates (or) the following general guidelines for submission of essay:**

- i. Only one Essay per entrant/student is allowed. Once the Essay is submitted it is final and no revision is allowed. The student should clearly mention his/her Name, Institution name with Address, Course name, Mobile number and e-mail address (In the end of essay).
- ii. The Essay should be written in English (Times New Roman) in single line spacing and not exceeding 1500 words in **word or pdf format**.
- iii. The Essay should be submitted **on or before 9<sup>th</sup> November 2015** (24:00hrs) **only through e-mail to the address as notified by the respective state Directorate of Technical Education** (or) to the AICTE Regional Office e-mail address as mentioned below:

RESOLUTION

There have been consistent demands from various sections of the society to observe 11<sup>th</sup> November, the birthday of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad, a great Freedom Fighter, an eminent Educationist and the first Union-Minister of Education, in a befitting manner. Several State Governments have also supported the demand. Accordingly, the Central Government has decided to observe 11<sup>th</sup> November, every year, as the "National Education Day" throughout the country, without declaring it as a holiday.

2. Ministry of Human Resource Development has decided to commemorate the birthday of this great Son of India by recalling his contribution to the cause of education in India. Educational Institutions at all levels would be involved in organizing seminars, symposia, essay-writing, elocution competitions, workshops and rallies with banners, cards and slogans on the importance of literacy and nation's commitment to all aspects of education on the "National Education Day". The focus of activities on the "National Education Day" would be on the various initiatives taken under Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA); in setting up model schools in secondary education; on the various initiatives taken in higher secondary education; and in vocational and higher education sectors by the Central Government on its own, and in partnership with State Governments, as well as through Private Public Partnership. These initiatives would be projected in association with

various industry bodies, whose fullest cooperation also would be sought in the development of human resources in the country.

3. All concerned are requested to ensure that the activities enumerated in Paragraph-2 of this Resolution are implemented by the institutions under their purview.
